Hoax Email

We would like to advise parents that we were one of the schools who received the HOAX email this morning. We immediately contacted the Police and the Local Authority who advised us this was a hoax and nearly every school in the area had received one. We were advised at that time that both the Police and Local Authority would be issuing statements and to wait for this before we informed parents. Below is the statement from the Detective Chief Inspector Stuart Miller:

“We’ve been made aware of a hoax email sent to schools in the force area this morning 13 April 2018.

“We want to categorically reassure parents and children, staff and the wider public that this a non-credible threat that has been sent nationwide.

“Our primary concern is to ensure that schools are given guidance, up-to-date information and reassurance and above all that everyone is safe.

“Community officers have already been sent to schools to provide that reassurance.”

Following advice from the Police and Local Authority, I would like to reassure all parents that all procedures and advice has been followed. Please pick your children up from school at the normal time. We appreciate your understanding.
